JUNE 2015 UCR SUMMARY

In June 2015, thirteen (13) uniformed crimes were documented in Lakeview (See Table Below)

JUNE UNIT STATISTICS: 683 complaints, 204 residence checks, 317 business checks, 80 traffic stops, issued, 80 verbal traffic warnings, 12 traffic tickets, and conducted 77 field interviews. Proactive investigations resulted in 16 arrests for the month.

JULY 2015 UCR SUMMARY

In July 2015, twenty-three (23) uniformed crimes were documented in Lakeview going against nine (22) the previous year, which reflects a **5%** increase compared to July 2014 statistics. Two incidents were person's crimes, one (1) armed robbery, and one (1) attempted simple robbery; whereby the attempted simple robbery was cleared by arrest.

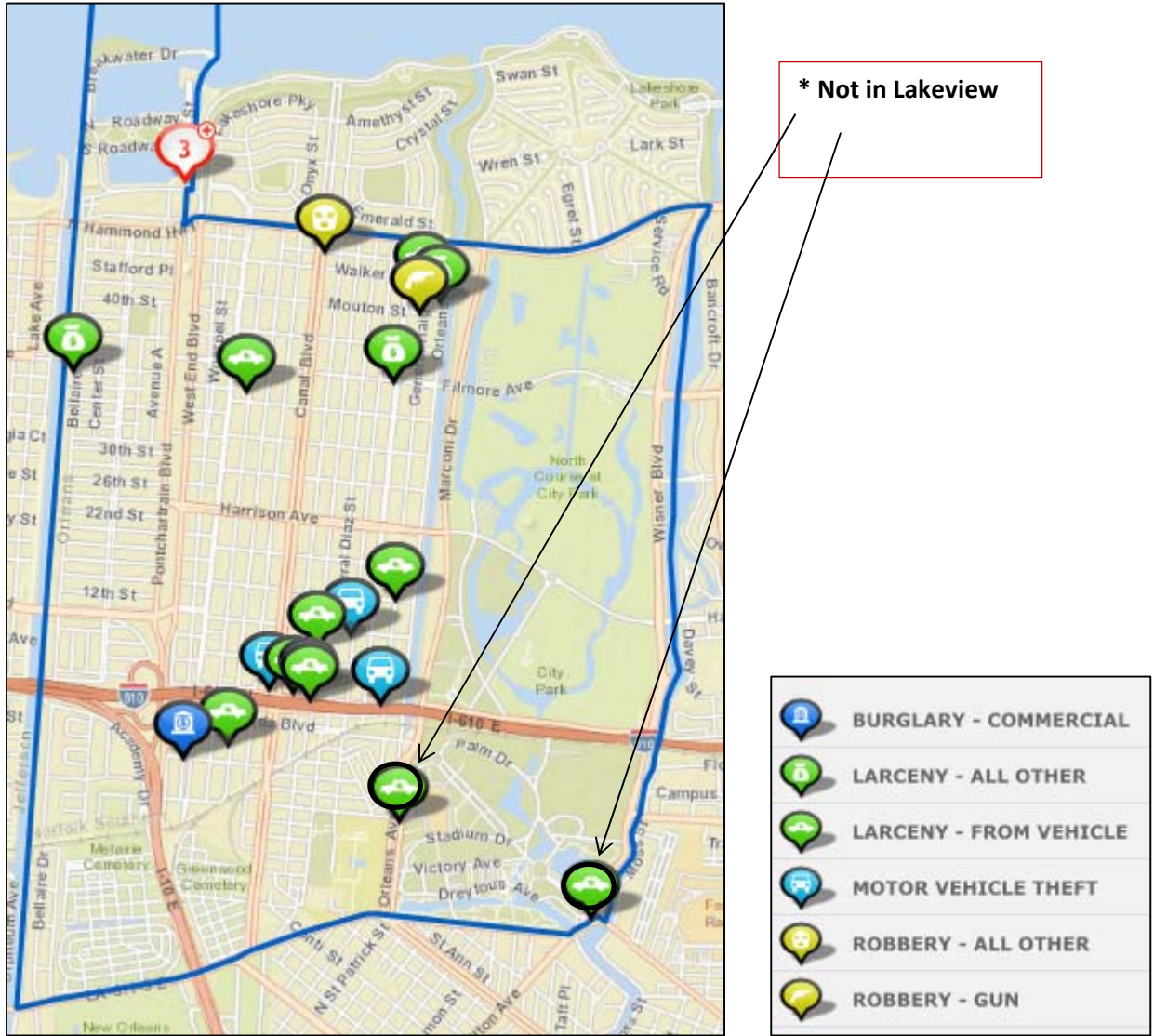

NOTEWORTHY ARRESTS:

BUSINESS BURGLARY ARREST – 203 HOMEDALE ST.

On 07/25/15 at 5:53a, Unit 361 responded to a 62A at the “Lots of Luck Bar” located at 203 Homedale St. The business is surrounded by a 7 foot locked wooden fence which made it difficult to view the side and rear of the business and the officer was unable to determine if entry was made.

Business owner arrived at work at 11:00 a.m. and observed the side door was pried open then discovered bags of money containing approximately \$7000.00 of business and video poker proceeds were stolen from a hidden location behind the bar. Video surveillance revealed a W/M perpetrator, entered the bar and stole the property. Perpetrator was positively identified as a known customer who lived near the business and frequently visited the bar several times daily.

On 7/25/15 at 7:56p, Officers secured a warrant for the arrest of Thomas Robeau, W/M, DOB 12/09/1967. At 8:30p, Mr. Robeau was arrested at his residence by 3rd District and LCPD officers without incident. He was charged with simple burglary of a business.

- Year to date, LCPD officers responded to 1266 false alarm calls for service.
- In July 2015 LCPD responded to 304 burglar alarms in the Lakeview area which represent 40% of all the complaints handled by the unit.
- 99% of dispatched burglar alarm calls for service were false alarms.
