Uniform Crimes are listed in two categories:

- Persons Crimes (Aggravated Battery, Armed Robbery, Homicide, and Rape)
- Property Crimes (Burglary, Larceny (Theft), Shoplifting, etc.)

## LAKEVIEW FEBRUARY 2016 CRIME REPORT

### INCIDENT GIST

In FEBRUARY 2016, Nine (9) UCR crimes were reported Lakeview

- **02 PERSONS CRIMES**

- (1) **Armed Robbery** – Incident occurred 02/12/2016 (762 Harrison Ave; NOLA BEAN)
  - At 8:52pm, armed subject entered rear door of NOLA bean, 8 minutes prior to closing, and asked employee where the safe was. Employee escorted subject to cash box and opened it with key.
  - At 8:54pm - Perpetrator fled business through the back door with approximately \$500 in cash.
  - At 9:01pm – NOPD was notified of the robbery. (**7 minutes after robbery**)
  - At 9:03 pm – The 1<sup>st</sup> LCPD Unit arrived on scene (**2 minute response time**)
  - **Perpetrator had a 9 minute head start to make good his escape.**
  - Evidence recovered from scene.
  - Detective Gus James has developed a suspect.
  - Investigation is ongoing.
  
- (1) **Simple Robbery** – Incident occurred 02/23/16 (6400 Blk Orleans Ave)
  - Around 1:00 a.m. victim met female on Bourbon Street.
  - At 2:05 am, the couple arrived at victim's residence to socialize
  - Around 4:15a, while inside the victims home, the female sprayed the victim in the face with pepper spray and took his cell phone, wallet, and \$3200 Corum Wrist Watch.
  - At 4:33a, victim activated his panic alarm at his residence
  - At 4:34a, the first LCPD unit arrived on scene. (**1 minute response time**)
  - iPhone was tracked to the 6700 block of General Haig, where it was found in the grass.
  - Video surveillance shows the female perpetrator on foot headed south on General Haig tossing the phone at 4:20am.
  - **Perpetrator had a 14 minute head start on police and made good her escape.**
  - Evidence recovered from the scene may lead to an arrest.
  - Detective Gus James is the lead investigator.

## LAKEVIEW FEBRUARY 2016 CRIME REPORT

- **10 PROPERTY CRIMES**

- **(1) Residence Burglaries**

- No Forced entry. Victim believes a friend used the spare key and stole a basket containing \$100 in coins and a bottle of Adderall prescription medication.

- **(2) Thefts**

- Incident #1 - Boat stolen from lake docked behind boat house.
- Incident #2 - Employee stole \$63 from a cash register of business.

- ***Arrest warrant is on file.***

- **(4) Auto Burglaries**

- 3 incidents involved unlocked vehicles.
- 1 incident forced entry was used to access trunk.

- **(2) Auto Thefts**

- Incident #1 - Brother left victims car running in front residence while he ran inside to change his clothes. Returned 10 minutes later and discovered vehicle missing.
- Incident #2 - Truck stolen from in front residence.

- **(1) Shoplifting**

- Incident #1 – Five (5) bottles of liquor stolen from business.

Victim suspects that a friend, whom he allowed to live with him for a month, may have committed the theft.</li></ul>

No forced entry. Victim frequently leaves truck unlocked and used vehicle to travel to and from work and between jobs in Algiers. Unable to determine the precise location where firearm was stolen.</li></ul>

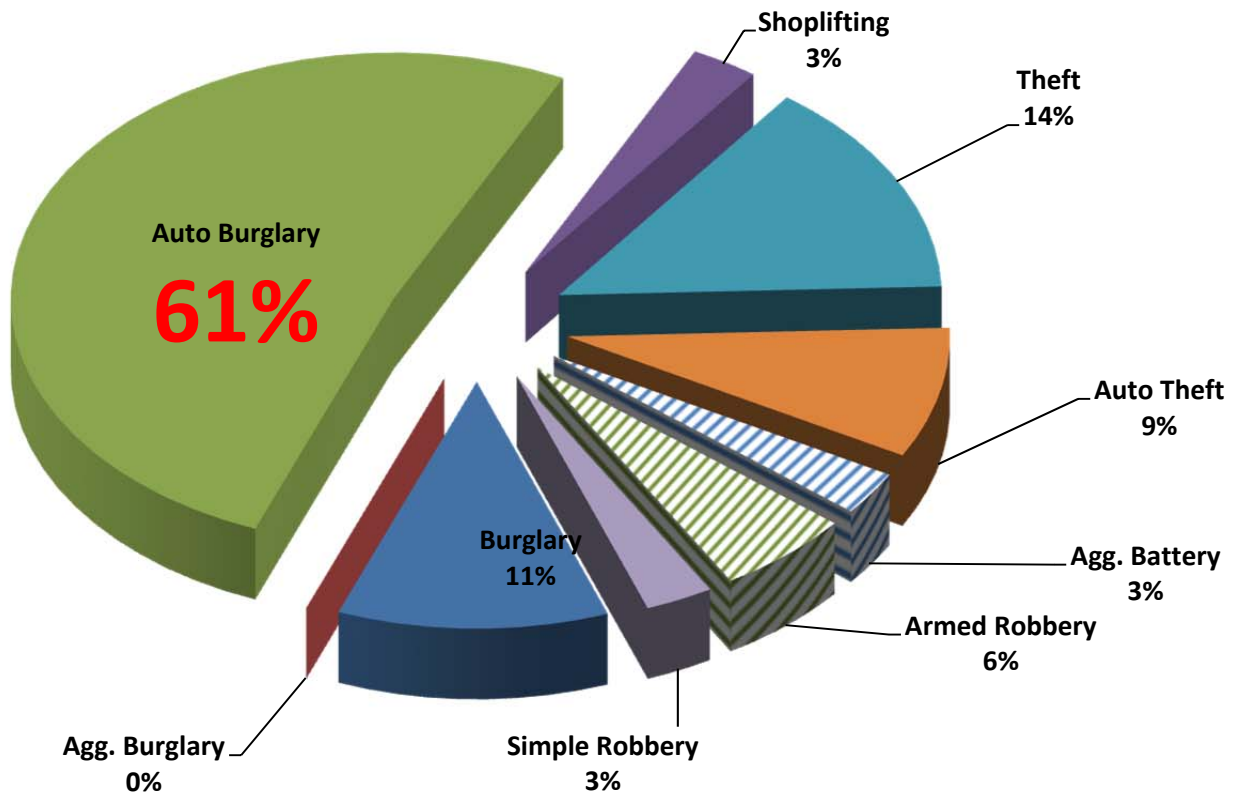

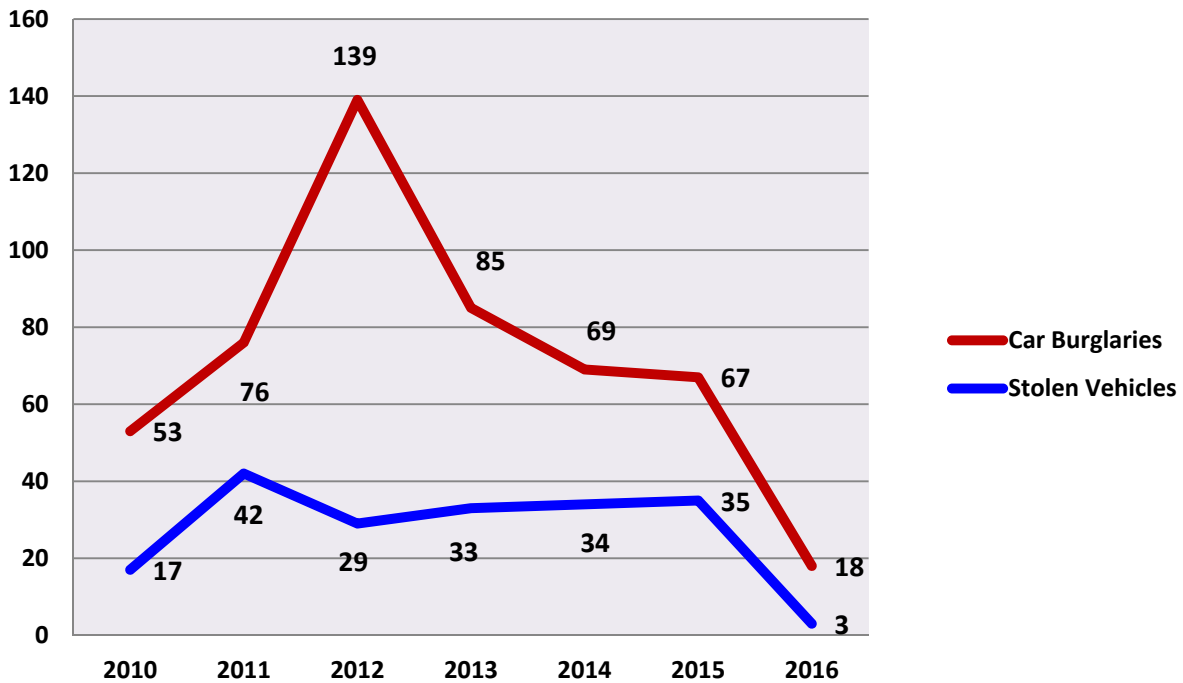

- **18 Auto Burglaries Reported**
  - 17 Vehicles were unlocked (94%)
  - In only one (1) incident forced entry was used
- **3 Auto Thefts Reported**
  - 1 Motor Cycle (key in ignition)
  - 1 Car (key in ignition and engine running)
  - 1 Truck
  - In 2 of the 3 cases, keys were with vehicle

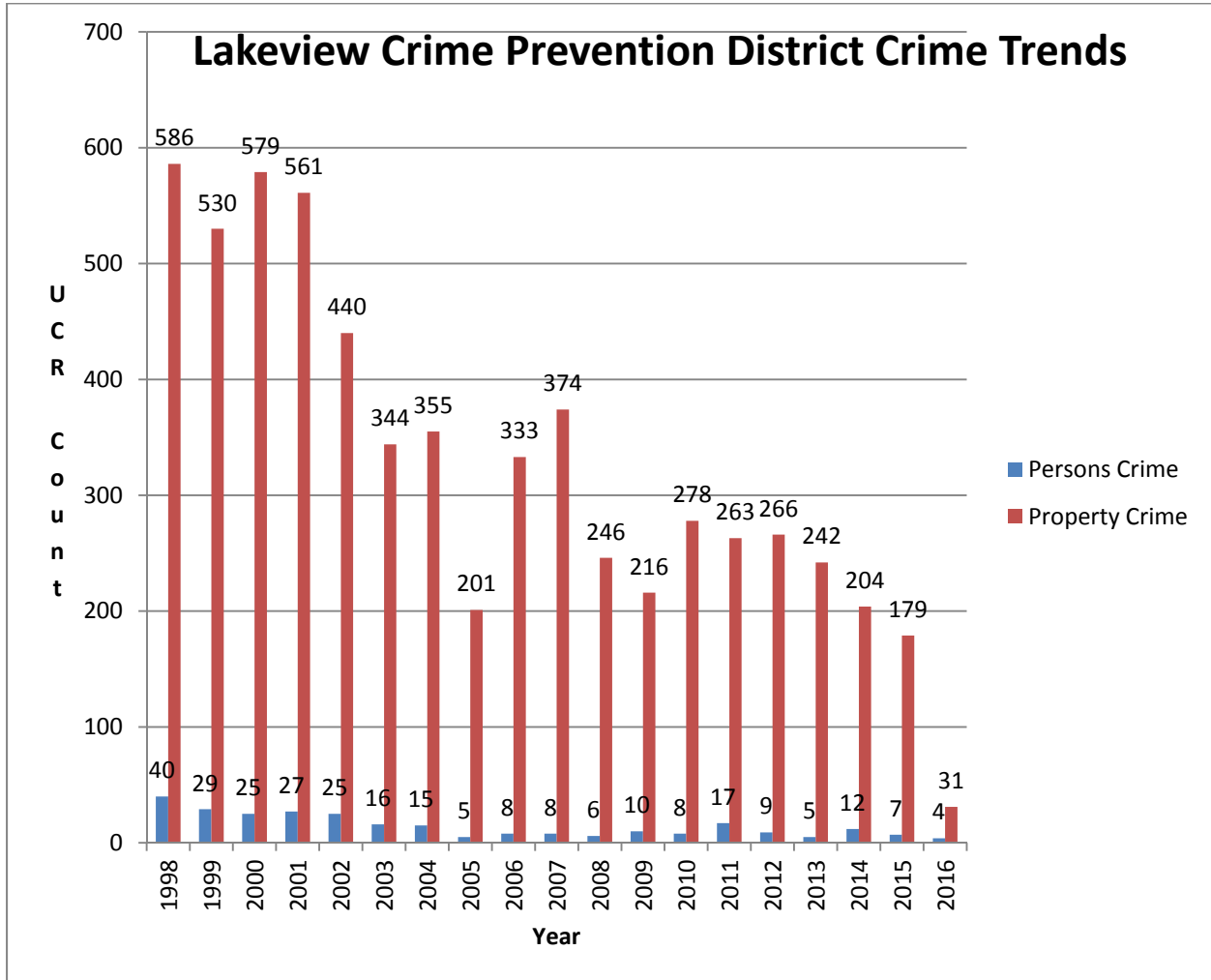
