WHAT IS A UNIFORM CRIME REPORT?



- In 1930, the International Association of Chiefs of Police created a way for law enforcement agencies to report crimes to the Federal Government called the “Uniform Crime Report”.
- Crime statistics are gathered from participating states on eight (8) index crimes.

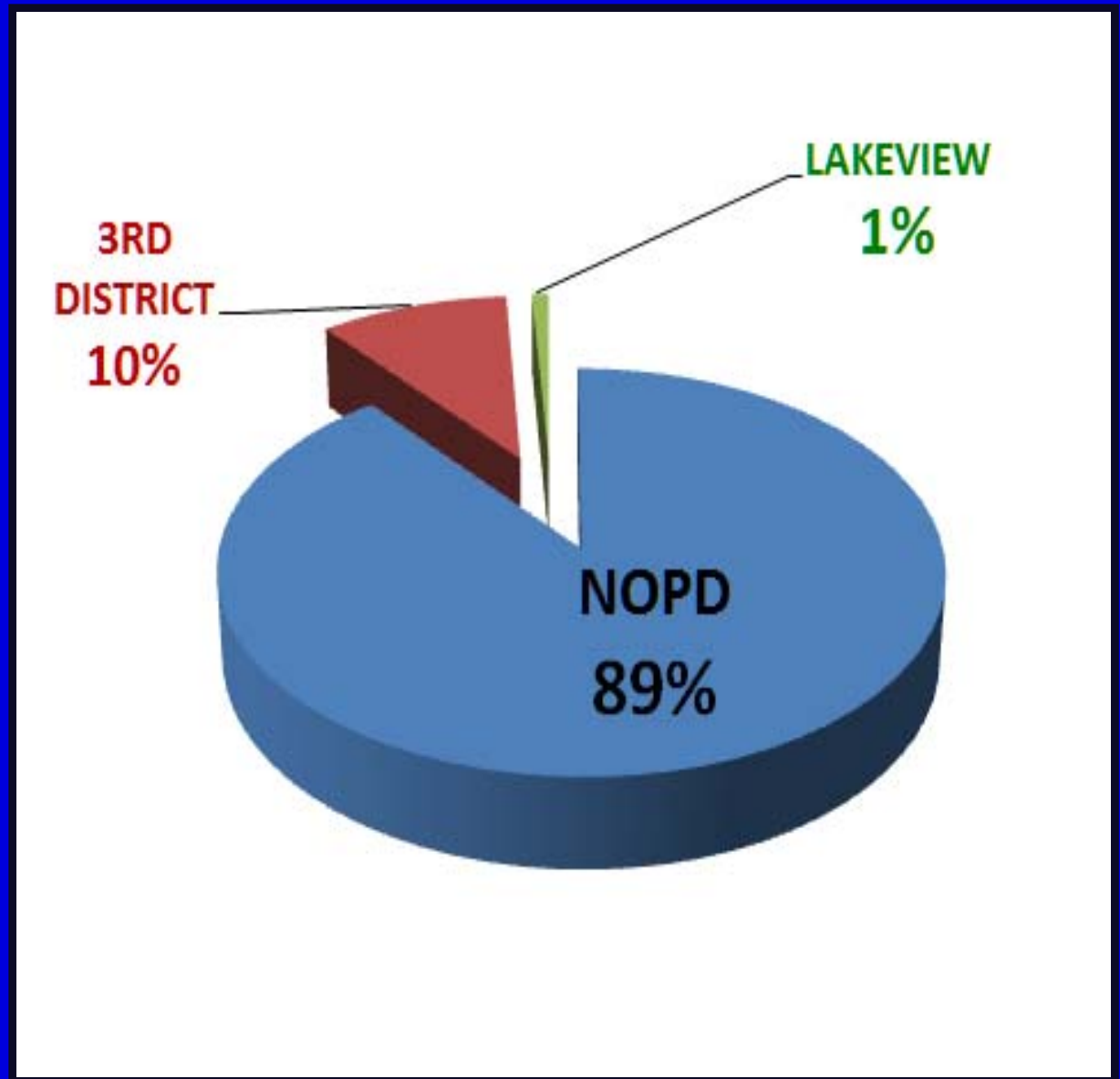

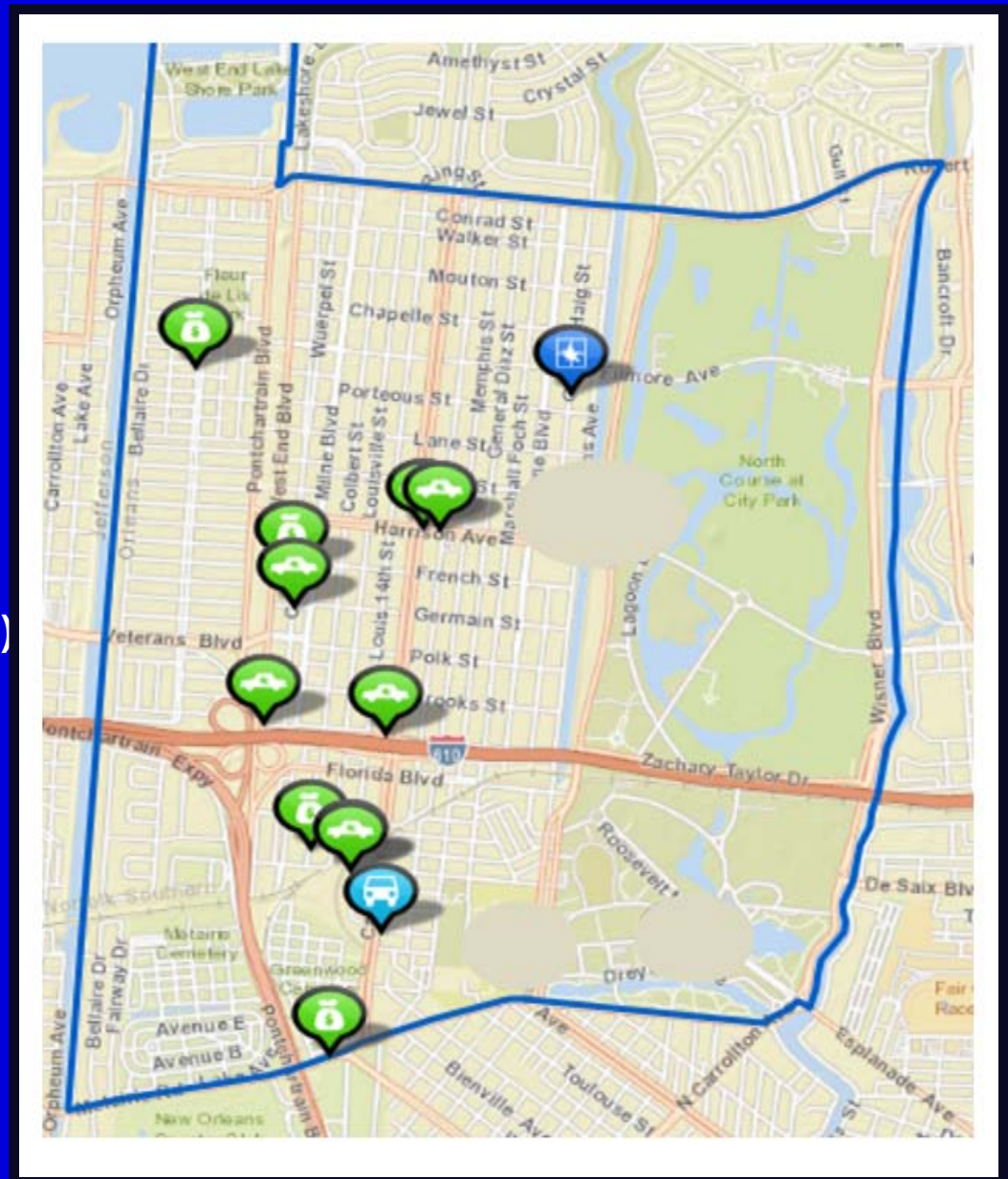

 - #2 Stolen microphone (Arrest)
 - #3 Stolen license plate
 - #4 Rims & tires stolen from vehicle parked in service alley.
 - #5 Bicycle stolen from porch by known contractor

- 80 Property Crimes (94%)

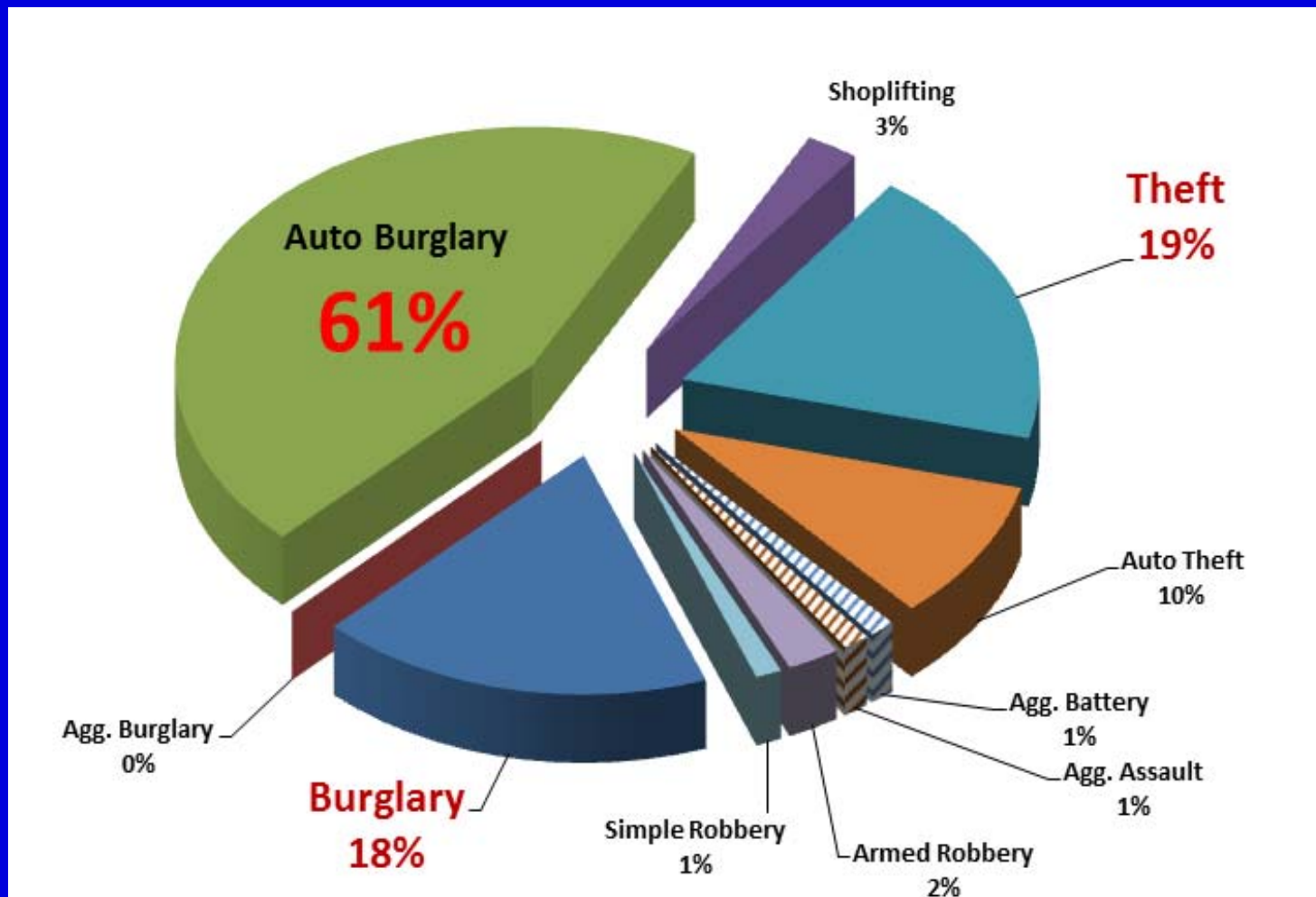

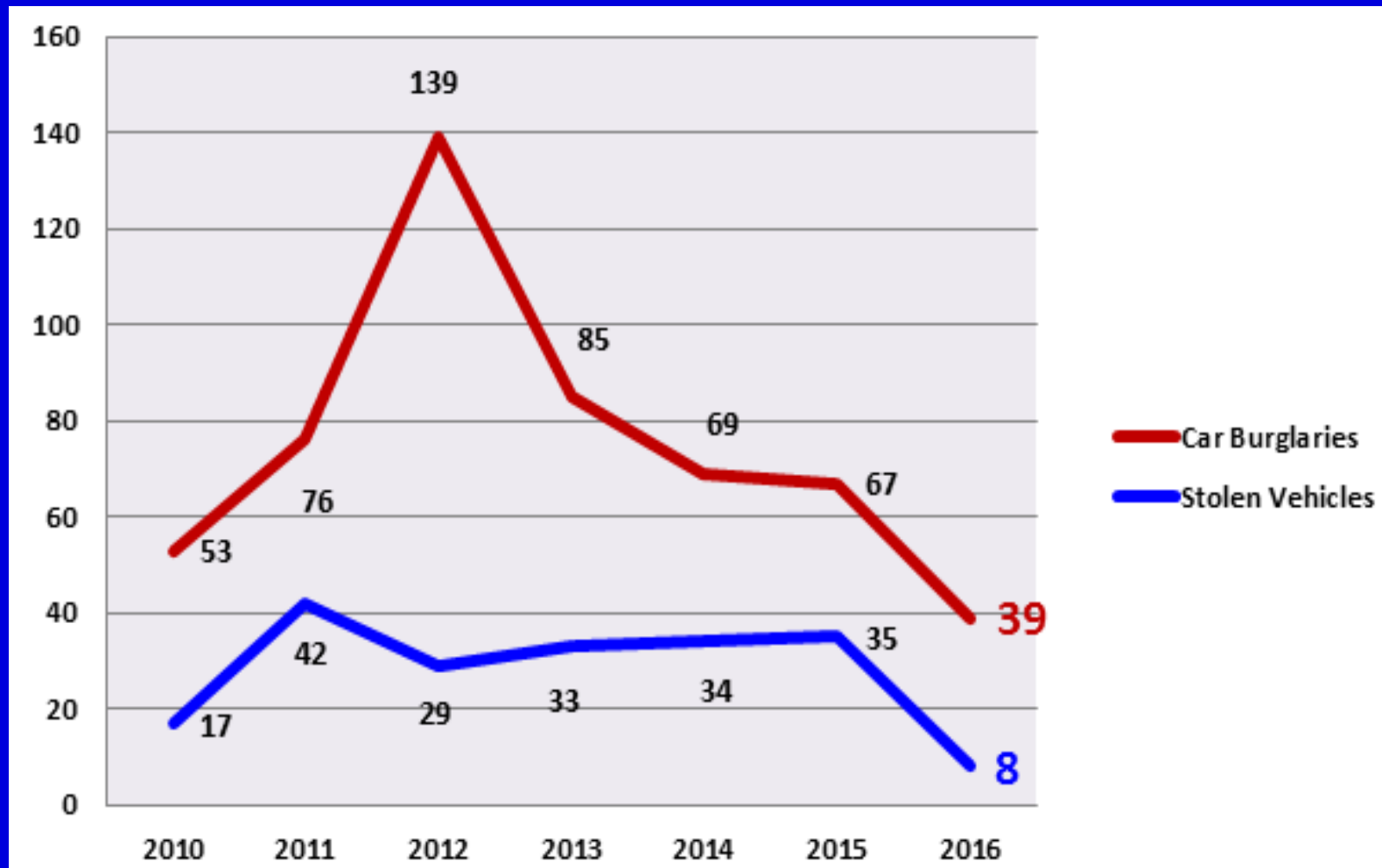

2016 AUTO BURGLARY UPDATE



- 39 Vehicle Burglaries Reported
 - 35 Vehicles Unlocked (90%)
 - 12 Cases Cleared by Arrest (38%)

Auto Burglary is up **18%** from 2015

2016 AUTO THEFT UPDATE (Jan – May)



- 8 Stolen Vehicles
 - 6 vehicles were Unlocked
 - 5 stolen with Keys
 - 4 vehicles recovered
 - 1 Case Cleared by Arrest
- Auto Theft is down **-27%** from 2015

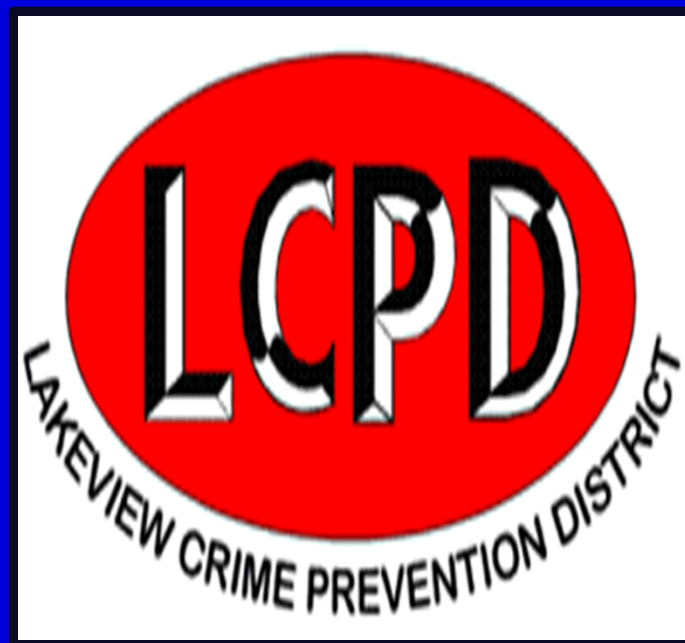

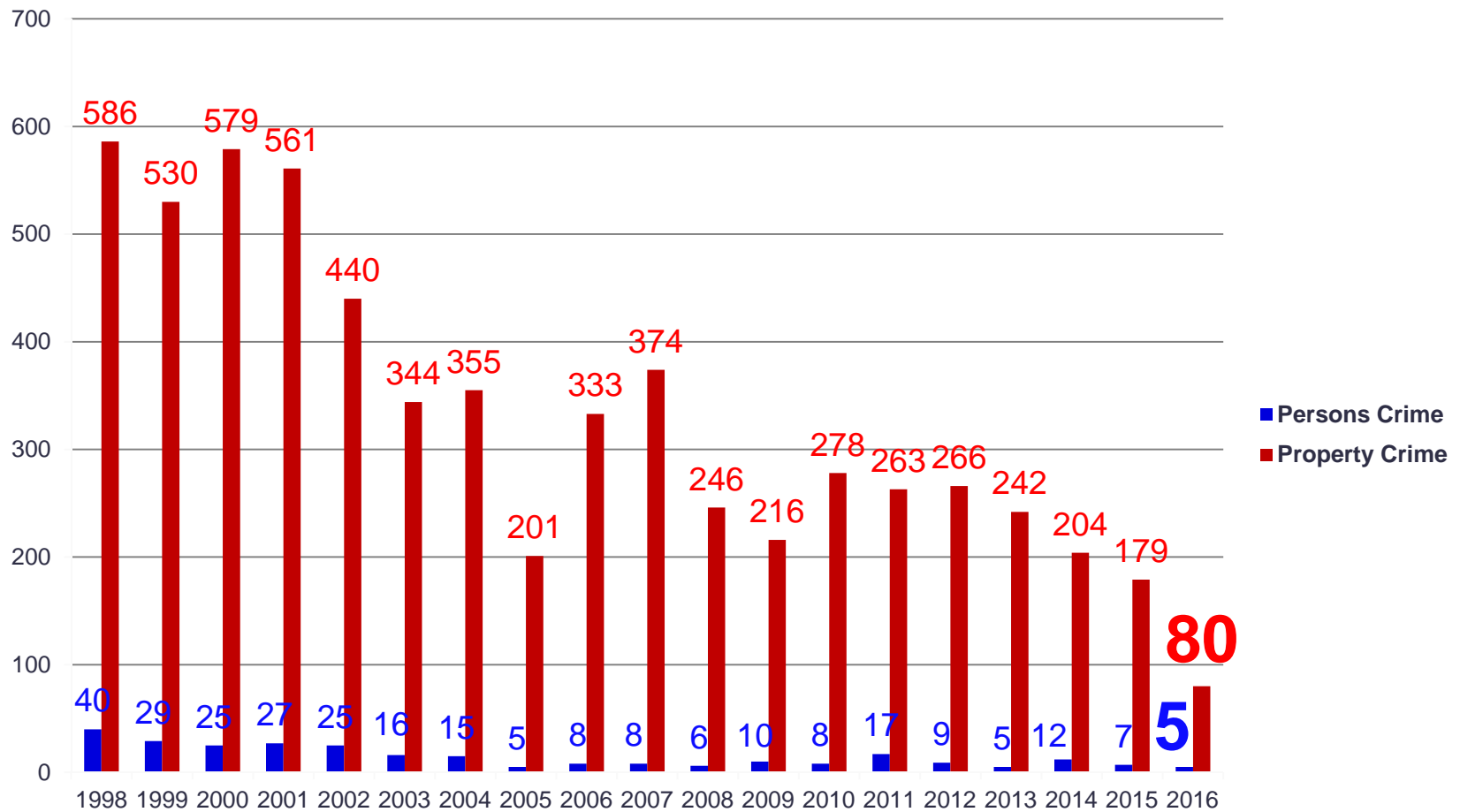

LCPD in reducing crime?

Ways community assistance can help reduce crime:

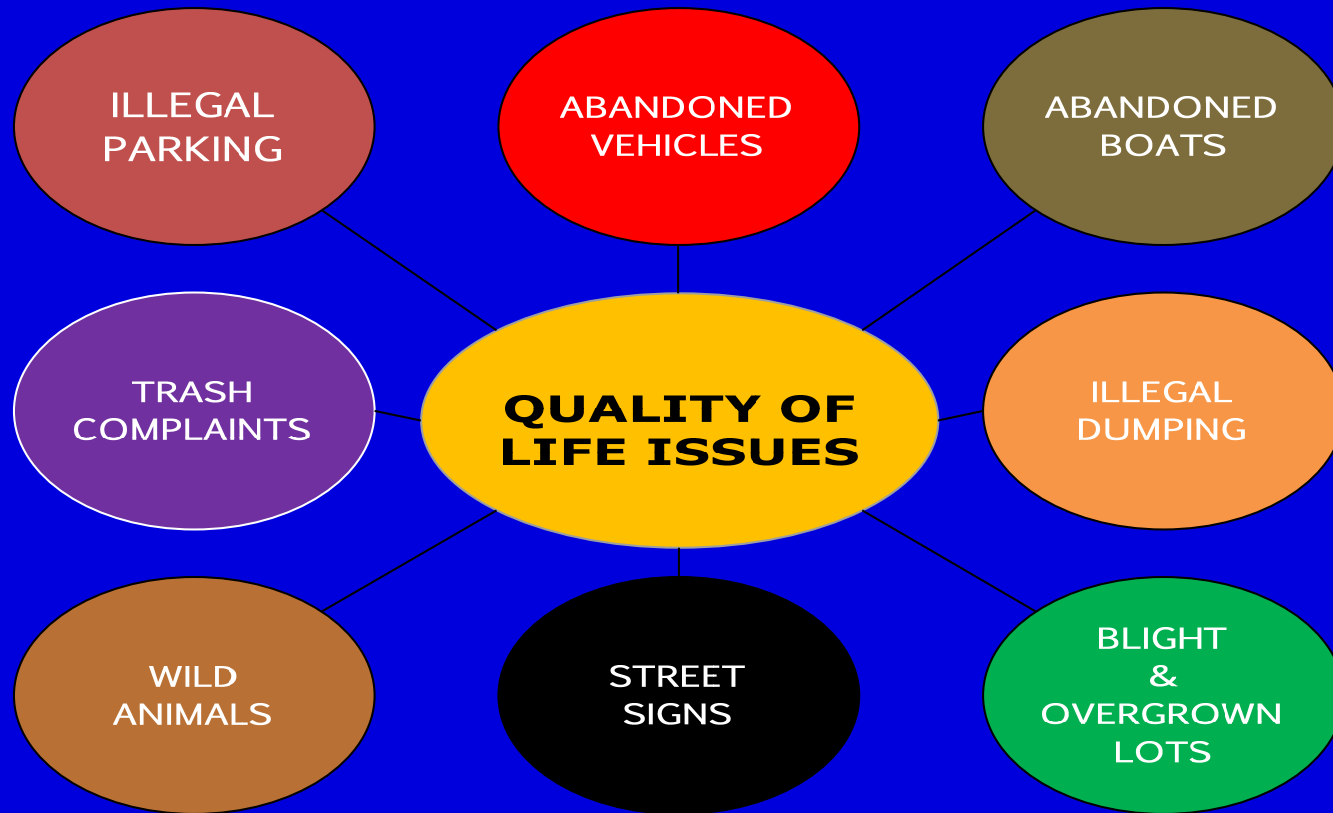
- Report suspicious activity in your neighborhoods
- Remove weapons and valuables from vehicles daily.
- Keep vehicles, homes, and sheds secured at all times.
- Remove car keys from vehicles
- Dial 911 to report crimes in progress or if suspicious activity poses a threat to your safety.



QUALITY OF LIFE CONCERNS:

- QOL complaints to City or State Agencies must be called in by phone to 311.
- Once the complaint is called in to 311, a work order number is generated and issued to the caller. The complaint is sent out to the respective city agency for handling.
- Follow Up - Citizens may call 311 and give the operator that work order number, to track the progress of the complaint.
